
MINUTES OF CIRCLE RELAXATION COMMITTEE (CRC) MEETING HELD ON 7TH AND 10TH JULY 2023 AT CIRCLE OFFICE, GUWAHATI TO CONSIDER CASES OF DECEASED DEPARTMENTAL EMPLOYEES FOR APPOINTMENT ON COMPASSIONATE GROUND AGAINST THE VACANCIES FOR THE YEAR 2021


The meeting of Circle Relaxation Committee (CRC) consisting of following officers was held on 07.07.2023 and 10.07.2023 to consider and examine the cases for appointment on compassionate grounds in relaxation to normal Recruitment Rules, of employees of the Department who died while in service.






However, it also provides for certain relaxations described hereunder:-

- (a) Upper age limit can be relaxed wherever found to be necessary. The Lower age limit should however, in no case be relaxed below 18 years of age.
- (b) In **exceptional** circumstances Govt. may consider recruiting persons not immediately meeting the minimum educational standard. Govt. may engage them as trainees who will be given the regular pay bands and grade pay only on acquiring the minimum qualification prescribed under the recruitment rules. The emoluments of these trainees, during the period of their training and before they are absorbed in the Government as employees, will be governed by the minimum of the-1S Pay Band (Pre-revised) of Rs.4440- 7440 without any Grade Pay. In addition, they will be granted all applicable allowances. The same shall be calculated on the minimum-1S pay band without any grade pay. The period spent in the -1S pay band by the future recruits will not be counted as service for any purpose as their regular service will start only after they are placed in the pay band of PB 1 Rs 5200-20200 along with grade pay of Rs. 1800.

- (c) In case of appointment of a widow not fulfilling the requirement of educational qualification against the post of Multi Tasking Staff, she will be placed in Group 'C'-Pay Band I (Rs 5200-20200) + Grade Pay Rs 1800/- directly without insisting on fulfilment of educational norms, in view of DoP&T OM No 14014/2/2009 Estt (D) dated 03.04 2012 and DoP& T OM No 14014/02/2012 Estt (D) dated 16.01.2013.

5. The ruling contained in the following judgments was also kept in view while considering the cases of compassionate appointment.

(i) The Hon'ble Apex Court in its judgment dated April 8, 1993 in the case of Auditor General of India and others vs. G. Ananta Rajeswara Rao has held that appointment on grounds of descent clearly violates Article 16(2) of the Constitution but if the appointment is confined to the son or daughter or widow of the Government servant who died in harness and who needs immediate appointment on grounds of immediate need of assistance in the event of there being no other earning member in the family to supplement the loss of income from the bread earner to relieve the economic distress of the members of the family, it is unexceptionable.

(ii) The Hon'ble Supreme Court's in its judgment dated May 4, 1994 in Umesh Kumar Nagpal case has laid down following important principles

a) Only dependents of an employee dying in harness leaving his family in penury and without any means of livelihood can be appointed on compassionate grounds.

b) The whole object of granting compassionate appointment is to enable the family to tide over the sudden crisis and to relieve the family of the deceased from financial destitution and to help it get over the emergency.


c) Offering compassionate appointment as a matter of course irrespective of the financial condition of the family of the deceased or medically retired Government servant is legally impermissible.

d) Compassionate Appointment cannot be granted after lapse of reasonable period and it is not vested right which can be exercised at any time in future.

iii) Hon'ble CAT, Jabalpur Bench in OA No 708 of 2008 in the matter titled as Kamlesh Trivedi vs. Union of India & others in its judgment dated 17.03.2009 held that "The family not found to be in penury conditions and there were more indigent person than the applicant. Thus the Tribunal would not be justified to reverse these findings recorded after complete appreciation of factual aspect."

iv) Hon'ble CAT, Ahmedabad Bench in OA No.179 of 2009 in the matter of Shri Brijesh Kumar D. Patel vs. Union of India & Others vide judgment dated 19/04/2010 held that "When subsequent to the death of the bread earner, sufficient time has passed and bereaved family has maintained themselves, there can be no direction to the competent authority to consider the claim for compassionate appointment. This is a factual finding and the Tribunal will not enter into merits of the same because whether the deceased left the family in penury without any means of livelihood has to be decided by the competent authority and the courts cannot normally interfere. Compassionate appointment cannot be claimed by way of right or as heritable public office".


v) In the case of HSEB vs. Krishna Devi it was held by the Hon'ble Apex Court that Compassionate appointment cannot be claimed as a matter of right against guidelines prescribed by the Government.


6. The CRC for the year 2021 is informed that, there are **13 (Thirteen) new applications** along with **46 (Forty Six) brought forwarded** cases which were recommended for deferment by the CRC for the year 2020.


7. Based on the criteria laid down in Directorate letter No 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23.03.2022, the Relative Merit Points were allocated for 10 attributes, 15 Bonus points were added wherever widow/wife applied for compassionate appointment. Allocation of point and total number of points of each applicant (59 applicants) are given a consolidated list at **Annexure A**. The application in the list have been taken in descending order of RMP. Based on the consolidated list, the candidates have been recommended on merit basis as per indigent points and their education, subject to availability of vacancies under compassionate appointment quota.

8. As per Para 5 of Postal Dte. Letter no. 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23.03.2022, the cases of applications considered for **three times or more** till the current CRC have been rejected.

9. The degree of indigence of each applicant in comparison to other cases received for consideration is arrived by the Circle Relaxation Committee taking into the account all the relevant factors and various attributes, subject to fulfilment of eligibility conditions as per instructions contained in Postal Directorate letter 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23.03.2022. The committee recommends total **4 (Four) most deserving cases** of applicants at **Sl. No.1, 2, 3 and 4** of consolidated list at **Annexure A having 87, 82, 81 and 78 RMP** respectively for appointment under compassionate grounds as mentioned in **Annexure B** strictly in order of merit arrived as per indigent points and eligibility criteria prescribed for educational qualification.

10. The CRC recommends the case of the applicant mentioned at SI No 2 of Annexure A, having 82 points (as per RMP) for appointment on compassionate ground for the post of MTS, as the candidate is only HSLC (Class 10th) passed and is not having the minimum educational qualification, i.e. (10+2) Standard or 12th Standard Pass, which is required for appointment as Postal Assistant/Sorting Assistant and Postman.
11. The CRC recommends the cases of the applicants mentioned at SI No 2, 3 and 4 of Annexure A, having 82, 81 and 78 points respectively (as per RMP) for appointment on compassionate ground subject to relaxation in upper age by the competent authority, in view of Para No 6 of B (a) of the scheme for compassionate appointment issued vide DoP&T OM No. 14014/02/2012-Estt (D) dated 16.01.2013. The details of the recommended candidates for whom relaxation of upper age limit is required, according to DoP&T O.M. No. 14014/02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 16.01.2013 is mentioned in Annexure E.
12. The CRC has also examined the case at SI No. 59 and found the same to be disputed. The deceased Late Atiqz Zaman, Ex IPO, Jorhat Sub Division had two wives and there is a dispute between both about settlement of pension case. Hence, till settlement of dispute between both of them the CRC is of the view that application for compassionate appointment is to be treated as disputed and to be considered only after settlement of the dispute between both the wives.
13. There are a total 14 (Fourteen) cases, mentioned in Annexure C considered by the CRC out of which 13 (Thirteen) cases could not be recommended due to non-availability of vacancies in Group C cadres in view of 5% ceiling of Direct Recruitment vacancy(ies) and the remaining one case of Ms. Jabeen Fatima was referred as it was not considered for recommendation being a disputed case. Therefore, these cases are recommended to be deferred and placed before next CRC.
14. 41 (Forty One) cases as per details given in Annexure D are examined by the members of the CRC and the committee recommends for rejection of these cases as all three chances for due consideration by respective CRC is exhausted as per applicable rules.
