


MINUTES OF CIRCLE RELAXATION COMMITTEE (CRC) MEETING HELD ON 5TH JULY 2023 AT CIRCLE OFFICE, GUWAHATI TO CONSIDER CASES OF DECEASED DEPARTMENTAL EMPLOYEES FOR APPOINTMENT ON COMPASSIONATE GROUND AGAINST THE VACANCIES FOR THE YEAR 2020

The meeting of Circle Relaxation Committee (CRC) consisting of following officers was held on 05.07.2023 to consider and examine the cases for appointment on compassionate grounds in relaxation to normal Recruitment Rules, of employees of the Department who died while in service.

2. The following is the vacancy position in different cadres in Group-C, arrived by calculating 5% of the total vacancies under Direct Recruitment Quota, meant for Compassionate Appointment for the year 2020 (01.01.2020 to 31.12.2020). The CRC has considered the cases of compassionate appointment limited to the extent of vacancies earmarked.





4. The consolidated instructions of DoP& T dated 16.01.2013 prescribes for eligibility of applicants seeking compassionate appointment. The applicant should be eligible and suitable for the post in all respects under the relevant Recruitment rules mentioned below:


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

However, it also provides for certain relaxations described hereunder:-


- (a) Upper age limit can be relaxed wherever found to be necessary. The Lower age limit should however, in no case be relaxed below 18 years of age.
- (b) In exceptional circumstances Govt. may consider recruiting persons not immediately meeting the minimum educational standard. Govt. may engage them as trainees who will be given the regular pay bands and grade pay only on acquiring the minimum qualification prescribed under the recruitment rules. The emoluments of these trainees, during the period of their training and before they are absorbed in the Government as employees, will be governed by the minimum of the-IS Pay Band (Pre-revised) of Rs.4440- 7440 without any Grade Pay. In addition, they will be granted all applicable allowances. The same shall be calculated on the minimum-IS pay band without any grade pay. The period spent in the -IS pay band by the future recruits will not be counted as service for any purpose as their regular service will start only after they are placed in the pay band of PB I Rs 5200-20200 along with grade pay of Rs. 1800.


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(c) In case of appointment of a widow not fulfilling the requirement of educational qualification against the post of Multi Tasking Staff, she will be placed in Group 'C'-Pay Band 1 (Rs 5200-20200) + Grade Pay Rs 1800/- directly without insisting on fulfilment of educational norms, in view of DoP&T OM No 14014/2/2009 Estt (D) dated 03.04 2012 and DoP& T OM No 14014/02/2012 Estt (D) dated 16.01.2013.

5. The ruling contained in the following judgments was also kept in view while considering the cases of compassionate appointment.

(i) The Hon'ble Apex Court in its judgment dated April 8, 1993 in the case of Auditor General of India and others vs. G. Ananta Rajeswara Rao has held that appointment on grounds of descent clearly violates Article 16(2) of the Constitution but if the appointment is confined to the son or daughter or widow of the Government servant who died in harness and who needs immediate appointment on grounds of immediate need of assistance in the event of there being no other earning member in the family to supplement the loss of income from the bread earner to relieve the economic distress of the members of the family, it is unexceptionable.

(ii) The Hon'ble Supreme Court's in its judgment dated May 4, 1994 in Umesh Kumar Nagpal case has laid down following important principles


a) Only dependents of an employee dying in harness leaving his family in penury and without any means of livelihood can be appointed on compassionate grounds.

b) The whole object of granting compassionate appointment is to enable the family to tide over the sudden crisis and to relieve the family of the deceased from financial destitution and to help it get over the emergency.


c) Offering compassionate appointment as a matter of course irrespective of the financial condition of the family of the deceased or medically retired Government servant is legally impermissible.

d) Compassionate Appointment cannot be granted after lapse of reasonable period and it is not vested right which can be exercised at any time in future.

iii) Hon'ble CAT, Jabalpur Bench in OA No 708 of 2008 in the matter titled as Kamlesh Trivedi vs. Union of India & others in its judgment dated 17.03.2009 held that "The family not found to be in penury conditions and there were more indigent person than the applicant. Thus the Tribunal would not be justified to reverse these findings recorded after complete appreciation of factual aspect."


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iv) Hon'ble CAT, Ahmedabad Bench in OA No.179 of 2009 in the matter of Shri Brijesh Kumar D. Patel vs. Union of India & Others vide judgment dated 19/04/2010 held that "When subsequent to the death of the bread earner, sufficient time has passed and bereaved family has maintained themselves, there can be no direction to the competent authority to consider the claim for compassionate appointment. This is a factual finding and the Tribunal will not enter into merits of the same because whether the deceased left the family in penury without any means of livelihood has to be decided by the competent authority and the courts cannot normally interfere. Compassionate appointment cannot be claimed by way of right or as heritable public office".


v) In the case of HSEB vs. Krishna Devi it was held by the Hon'ble Apex Court that Compassionate appointment cannot be claimed as a matter of right against guidelines prescribed by the Government.

6. The CRC for the year 2020 is informed that, there are **4 (Four) new applications** along with **53 (Fifty Three) brought forwarded** cases which were recommended for deferment by the CRC for the year 2019.


7. Based on the criteria laid down in Directorate letter No 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23.03.2022, the Relative Merit Points were **allocated for 10 attributes**, **15 Bonus points** were added wherever widow/wife **applied for compassionate appointment**. Allocation of point and total number of points of each applicant are given a consolidated list at **Annexure A**. The application in the list have been **taken in descending order of RMP**. Based on the consolidated list, the candidates have been recommended on merit basis as per indigent points and their education, subject to availability of vacancies under compassionate appointment quota.


8. As per Para 5 of Postal Dte. Letter no. 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23.03.2022, the cases of applications considered for three **times or more** till the current CRC have been rejected.

9. The degree of indigence of each applicant in comparison to other cases received for consideration is arrived by the Circle Relaxation Committee taking into the account all the relevant factors and various attributes, subject to fulfilment of eligibility conditions as per instructions contained in Postal Directorate letter 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23.03.2022. **The committee recommends total 2 (Two) most deserving cases of applicants at Sl. No.2 and 3** of consolidated list at **Annexure A** having 93 and 92 RMP respectively for **appointment under compassionate grounds** as mentioned in **Annexure B** strictly in order of merit arrived as per indigent points and eligibility criteria prescribed for educational qualification.

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
10. The applicant at Sl No. 1 of Annexure A has withdrawn her application vide letter dated 03.01.2023 and clearly expressed that she would like to withdraw her application seeking appointment on compassionate ground. She has further assured that she will not claim any appointment in Department of Posts in future under compassionate ground. Hence, the CRC has not recommended the case and the same has been considered for rejection.

11. The CRC recommends the cases of the applicants mentioned at Sl No 2 and 3 of Annexure A, having 93, 92 points respectively (as per RMP) for appointment on compassionate ground with relaxation in upper Age, in view of Para No 6 of B (a) of the scheme for compassionate appointment issued vide DoP&T OM No. 14014/02/2012-Estt (D) dated 16.01.2013.

12. The CRC has also examined the case at Sl No. 57 and found the same to be disputed. The deceased Late Atiquz Zaman, Ex IPO, Jorhat Sub Division had two wives and there is a dispute between both about settlement of pension case. Hence, till settlement of dispute between both of them the CRC is of the view that application for compassionate appointment is to be treated as disputed and to be considered only after settlement of the dispute between both the wives.


13. There are a total 46 (Forty Six) cases, mentioned in Annexure C considered by the CRC and not recommended only due to non-availability of vacancies in Group C cadres in view of 5% ceiling of Direct Recruitment vacancy(ies) and therefore, recommended to be deferred and placed before next CRC.

14. 9 (Nine) cases as per details given in Annexure D are examined by the members of the CRC and the committee recommends for rejection of these cases.
