

MINUTES OF THE CIRCLE RELAXATION COMMITTEE MEETING (CRC) HELD ON 07-07-2025 AT GUWAHATI FOR CONSIDERATION OF CASES FOR COMPASSIONATE APPOINTMENT OF DEPENDENTS OF DECEASED DEPARTMENTAL OFFICIALS UNDER COMPASSIONATE GROUNDS IN RELAXATION OF RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE VACANCY YEAR 2023 OF ASSAM CIRCLE

In accordance with the instructions contained in Directorate's letter no. 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23-03-2022 & 24-03-2022, the Circle Relaxation Committee (CRC) constituted by the Competent Authority comprising of the following officers met on 07-07-2025 to consider the cases of dependents of deceased officials of the Department seeking appointment on compassionate grounds in relaxation of normal recruitment rules to the cadres of Postal Assistant/ Sorting Assistants, Postman/Mail Guard & Multi-Tasking Staff in Assam Postal Circle. As per instructions contained in Directorate Letter No 17-12/2022-SPG-II dated 15-05-2024 & 27-06-2024, the cases which were received up to 30-06-2024 in the Online Portal for Compassionate Appointment have been taken into consideration by the Committee against the earmarked vacancies for compassionate appointment for the vacancy year 2023. The Committee considered a **total of 47 cases** which included **27 cases** referred to this Committee by earlier CRC held on 01-02-2024 to 02-02-2024.

Composition of CRC:

2. Summary of last CRC meeting held on 01-02-2024 to 02-02-2024: The previous Circle Relaxation Committee meeting for the vacancy year 2022 was held on 01-02-2024 to 02-02-2024. A total of **34 cases** were placed before the Committee for examination. As per approval of the Competent Authority, out of 34 cases, **4 cases were "Recommended" for appointment on compassionate grounds, 3 cases were "Rejected", and 27 cases were 'referred' to next CRC**.

3. Cases Placed before present CRC: The cases have been examined/considered in accordance with Directorate/DoP&T instructions/guidelines issued and amended from time to time as appended below:-

- a) DoP&T OM No. 14014/6/14-Estt.a) dated 09-10-1998,
- b) DoP&T OM No. 14014/02/2012-Estt.a) dated 16-01-2013,
- c) FAQ in DoP&T OM No. 14014/02/2012-Estt.a) dated 30-05-2013,
- d) Revised relative merit points issued vide Directorate letter no. 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23-03-2022
- e) Standard Operating Procedure issued vide Directorate letter no. 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 24-03-2022
- f) Directorate's clarifications issued vide letter nos. 17-I/2022-SPG-II dated 20-07-2023, 24-44/2022-SPG-II dated 10-11-2023

The Committee has analysed each case based on the parameters prescribed in the above mentioned guidelines/consolidated instructions while determining the indigence of the applicants. The points generated automatically by the Online Portal for compassionate appointment have been verified by the CRC with the data entry made.

4. Vacancy Position:

(i) The following is the vacancy position in different cadres in Group 'C' which was arrived @ **5% of the total vacancies** under Direct Recruitment Quota meant for Compassionate Appointment for the vacancy year 2023 as per the Directorate orders on the subject. The CRC has considered the cases for Compassionate Appointment limited to the extent of vacancies earmarked.

(ii) As per the guidelines issued on the scheme for compassionate appointment circulated vide DoPT OM No. 14014/6/94-Estt(D) dated 09-10-1998 and 14014/02/2012-Estt(D) dated 16-01-2013, the Circle Relaxation Committee constituted for considering requests for appointment on compassionate grounds should limit its recommendation to appointment on compassionate grounds in deserving cases based on the availability of vacancy meant for appointment under compassionate grounds, within the ceiling of 5% of vacancies falling under Direct Recruitment Quota.

5. **(a) Recruitment Rules Applicable for the Vacancies:** As per the existing Recruitment Rules, 2022 for PA/SA cadre and amended time to time, the applicant should have passed Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University & Institute for Direct Recruitment Quota. Also, as per recruitment (Amendment) rules, 2023 prevalent for Postman/Mail Guard cadre, the educational qualification required is 12th standard pass from a recognized board subject to conditions mentioned in RR, possess knowledge of working on computer and possess a valid Driving License of two wheeler or Light Motor Vehicle. Further, as per Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2023 of Multi-Tasking Staff Cadre, the educational qualification required for the applicant is 10th standard pass from a recognised Board and should have studied local language at least up to 10th Standard.



(b) The consolidated instructions of DoP & T dated 16.01.2013 prescribes for eligibility of applicants seeking compassionate appointment. The applicant should be eligible and suitable for the post in all respects under the relative Recruitment rules mentioned below:

7. Degree of Indigence:

a. As per Directorate's letter no. 17-12/2022-SPG-II dated 27-06-2024, CRC till vacancy year 2023 would be convened as per the existing RMPS circulated vide letter no. 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23.03. 2022. The new RMPS, duly revised, shall be applicable for the vacancy year 2024 and onwards.

b. In view of point (a) above, the degree of indigence of each applicant has been arrived at as per the guidelines issued by Postal Directorate vide letter no. 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23-03-2022 subject to fulfilment of eligibility conditions as per Recruitment Rules. As per DOP&T OM no. 14014/2/2009-Estt (D) dated 11-12-2009 and 14014/02/2012-Estt. (D) dated 16-01-2013, if an applicant (other than Spouse) requests for compassionate appointment and does not fulfil the minimum educational qualification in exceptional circumstances, they can be restricted to MTS cadre and recruited as 'Trainee'.

c. In case of appointment of a widow not fulfilling the required educational qualification, for the posts of Multi-Tasking Staff there is a provision for relaxation of requirement of educational qualification by Head of the Circle subject to the condition that she can satisfactorily perform duties of the post with the help of some on job training. This was taken into consideration while examining such cases and recommended accordingly.

d. The committee has recommended for Selection to the Posts according to the relative merit points secured by the applicants, subject to fulfilment of other eligibility conditions and order of preference exercised by the candidates subject to availability of vacancies in the respective Cadre. The date of death has been considered as cut-off date for assessing the indigent condition of the applicant under RMPS for Compassionate Appointment.

e. In accordance with Directorate's instructions issued vide letter no. 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23-03-2022, in case two or more applicants get equal merit points under Relative Merit Point System (RMPS), preference is given to those cases in which amount of family pension is less. If the amount of family pension also remains equal, then amount of terminal benefits is considered for giving preference.

8. Details of cases Examined and Recommended / Rejected by CRC:

The complete list of all 47 cases generated from Online Portal as **Annexure - II** was examined by the CRC.

(a) (i) Recommended by CRC for appointment on Compassionate Grounds: Based on the revised Relative Merit Point System issued by Directorate vide letter no. 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23-03-2022, out of the 47 cases, the **(4) four most deserving cases** from eligible applicants who secured highest points as per RMPS except as mentioned in point no. **8(iii)**, have been recommended by the CRC for appointment on compassionate grounds to the extent of vacancies available/earmarked for compassionate appointment subject to age relaxation by HoC. The CRC decided to recommend the provisional appointment of the applicants who came up in the selection



zone, depending upon their suitability/solely based on merit points secured to the extent of 5% Direct Recruitment vacancies reserved for compassionate appointment quota, also keeping in view of the eligibility criteria mentioned under prevalent Recruitment Rules of Postal Assistant/ Sorting Assistant, Postman/Mail Guard and Multi-Tasking Staff subject to relaxations on age, educational qualifications as the case may be. The details of (4) four recommended cases generated from Online Portal is furnished as **Annexure - III.**

(ii) As per consolidated instructions on the scheme for compassionate appointment communicated vide DoP&T OM F.No.14014/02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 16-01-2013, **upper age limit could be relaxed wherever found necessary, by the HOC.** Also, the belated cases (cases which are 05 years or older), earning member cases are required to be forwarded to Directorate for consideration/approval as per Directorate's letter No.17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 24-03-2022.

(iii) The applications with respect to **Late Shankar Paul Choudhury (SI No. 45)** and **Late Utpal Sarma (SI No. 12)** for the **Sorting Assistant** position were not recommended. Although both candidates had **RMP scores of 77**, they did not meet the required educational qualifications for the role.

(iv) The Committee recommends that the Divisional Heads should ensure that all applicants recommended for provisional appointment are fulfilling the Educational and other qualifications as per the relevant Recruitment Rules before issuing provisional appointment orders. Provisional appointment is subject to the condition that the approved candidate will maintain the dependent family members of the deceased Govt. servant, and if found neglecting them, his/her appointment may be terminated.

(b) Rejected by CRC due to consideration of cases for third time / ineligible cases:

(i) Out of the 47 cases, 7 cases which have been placed for third time before the CRC, were considered and **'REJECTED' (Annexure V)** by the CRC as per instructions contained under point no. 5 of Directorate's letter no. 17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 23-03-2022 and did not fall under the 4 cases selected based on the vacancy position in each cadre, due to less points and less indigence. While arriving at this decision, the committee also kept in view the instructions mentioned vide Postal Directorate letter no. 24-157/2013-SPB-1/c dated 04-04-2016.

Postal Directorate vide Para 3(i) of letter no. 24-157/2013-SPB-1/c dated 04-04-2016 had mentioned that

"Appointment on compassionate grounds is intended to render immediate assistance to the family of a government servant who dies in harness or retires on invalidation on medical grounds leaving his/her family in financial crisis. Such appointment is restricted to 5% of direct recruitment vacancies. As number of cases for compassionate appointment is much more than the number of vacancies available for the purpose, the most deserving cases are only recommended for compassionate appointment. Para 3(ii) of Postal Directorate letter 24-157/2013-SPB-1/c dated 04-04-2016 also mentioned that

"As per DOP&T instructions a case can be considered for compassionate appointment even where the death or retirement on medical grounds of a Government Servant took place long back, say five years or so. While considering such belated requests it was, however, to be related to the need for immediate assistance to the family of Government servant in order to relieve it from economic distress. The very fact that the family has been able to manage somehow all these years should normally be taken as adequate proof that the family had some dependable means of subsistence."

9. **Referred to Next CRC cases:** The CRC has decided to refer cases to 'Next CRC' due to paucity of vacancies in the eligible cadre. The details of **36 (thirty six)** such cases generated from Online Portal is furnished as **Annexure-IV**.

10. The rules/principles of law laid down by the Hon'ble Courts in connection with considering appointments on compassionate grounds contained in the following judgements are also kept in view while considering cases for compassionate appointments:

(i) The Hon'ble Apex Court in its judgement date April 8, 1993 in the case of Auditor General of India and others Vs. G. Ananta Rajeswara Rao [(1994) 1 SSC 192] has held that Appointment on grounds of descent clearly violates Article 16(2) of the constitution but if the appointment is confined to the son or daughter or widow of the Government servant who died in harness and who needs immediate appointment on grounds of immediate need of assistance in the event of there being no other earning member in the family to supplement the loss of income from the bread winner to relieve the economic distress of the members of the family, it is unexceptionable.

(ii) As per Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated May 4, 1994 in the case of Umesh Kumar Nagpal Vs. State of Haryana and others (JT 1994(3) SC 525] has laid down the following important principles in this regard:

- a) Only dependents of an employee dying in harness leaving family in penury and without means of livelihood can be appointed on compassionate grounds.
- b) The whole object of granting compassionate appointment is to enable the family to tide over sudden crisis and to relieve the family of the deceased from financial condition of the family of the deceased or medically retired Government servant is legally impermissible.
- c) Offering compassionate appointment as a matter of course irrespective of financial condition of the family of the deceased or medically retired Government servant is legally impermissible.
- d) Compassionate Appointment cannot be granted after lapse of reasonable period and is not a vested right which can be exercised at any time in future.

(iii) Under point no. 59 of FAQs issued by DoPT vide No. 14014/02/2012-Estt(D) dated 30-05-2013, it has been stated that "The Supreme Court has held in its judgement dated February 28, 1995 in the case of the Life Insurance Corporation of India Vs. Mrs Asha Ramchandra Ambedkar and others [JT 1994(2) S.C. 183] that the High Courts and Administrative Tribunals cannot give direction for appointment of a person on



compassionate grounds but can merely direct consideration of the claim for such an appointment."

(iv) The Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of Director of Treasuries in Karnataka and Anr. Vs. V. Sowmyashree, 2021 SCC Online SC 704, had occasion to consider the principle governing the grant of appointment on compassionate ground. After referring to the decision of the Apex Court in N.C. Santhosh Vs. State of Karnataka (2020) 7 SCC 617, the Apex Court has summarised the principle governing the grant of appointment on compassionate ground as under:-


- a) That the compassionate appointment is an exception to the general rule.
- b) That no aspirant has a right to compassionate appointment.
- c) The Appointment to any public post in the service of the State has to be made on the basis of the principle in accordance with Articles 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India.
- d) Appointment on compassionate grounds can be made only on fulfilling the norms laid down by the State's policy and/or satisfaction of the eligibility criteria as per the policy;
- e) The norms prevailing on the date of consideration of the application should be the basis.

(v) Hon'ble CAT, Jabalpur Bench order dated 17.03.2009 OA No. 708 of 2008 in Kamlesh Trivedi Vs. Union of India & others: "The family is not found to be in penury conditions and there were more indigent persons than the applicant. Thus the Tribunal would not be justified to reverse these findings".

(vi) Hon'ble CAT, Ahmadabad Bench order dated 19.04.2010 in OA No.179 of 2009 in Shri Brijesh Kumar D. Patel Vs. Union of India & Others: "when subsequent to the death of the bread earner, sufficient time has passed and bereaved family has maintained themselves, there can be no direction to competent authority to consider the claim for compassionate appointment. This is finding and the Tribunal will not enter into merits of the same because whether the deceased left the family in penury and without any means of livelihood has to be decided by competent authority and the courts can not normally interfere. Compassionate appointment cannot be claimed as a matter of right or as heritable public office.

(vii) In the case of HSEB Vs. Krishna Devi [JT 2003 (3) SC 485]: Held by Apex Court that compassionate appointment cannot be claimed as a matter of right and against government guidelines prescribed by the Government.

(viii) In the recent orders issued in one of the OAs by Hon'ble CAT dated 29-11-2022, it has been stated that "If appointment is made at a later stage, the same shall be against the object and purpose for which compassionate ground appointment is provided, as the whole object of compassionate appointment is to enable the family of the deceased Government servant to tide over sudden crisis; it is not a source of recruitment.



11. As per the SOP for compassionate appointment issued vide Directorate letter No.17-1/2022-SPG-II dated 24-03-2022, recommendations of the CRC may be placed before the Chief Postmaster General for consideration. HoC may agree or disagree. If HoC disagrees with the recommendations of CRC, the case will be forwarded to Directorate for final decision in the matter.


